Policy on Damage to Personal Property on Campus

The College does not assume responsibility for acts of God that result in damage to personal property of students, employees or visitors. Personal property includes but is not limited to cars, trucks, and electronic equipment. By parking near recreational or athletic areas, the driver and owner of any vehicle assume all liability related to theft of articles inside of vehicles, vandalism, falling tree branches and flying objects such as footballs, soccer balls and baseballs.

This policy follows the standard insurance industry practice of owners of personal property insuring all personal property under a homeowners/renters or auto liability insurance policy. To assist you in filling a claim with your insurance company, Public Safety may investigate and file a report if requested. The process of taking the report does not change the College's policy or assume responsibility.
