Application to Live Off-Campus

The Wofford College Student Handbook & Policies states:

All single students, except those commuting daily from their homes or homes of relatives (i.e., grandparents, aunts, or uncles) are required to live in college housing and to take their meals in the college dining hall.

The College, upon application, may grant exceptions in the following cases:

1. A student who is in active military service or who is a veteran of two years of military service.
2. A student who is regularly employed thirty-five hours or more each week and whose schedule would make living in college housing or taking meals in the college dining hall impractical.
3. A student who cannot live in college housing due to health concerns must provide documentation from a certified physician or practicing psychologist and be approved by the College physician.
