TIPS:

- · Please review the campus map for parking lot locations and traffic flow plans.
- Consider carpooling, either from home or meeting somewhere off campus before coming to campus.
- Give yourself a few extra minutes travel time to all commencement events.
- As you get closer to campus, look for signs about parking locations for general parking and accessible lots.
- Shuttle locations will be located throughout campus. These shuttles are available for those who require mobility assistance. Limited to you and one companion. Shuttles will be available before and after the ceremony at the drop-off locations.
- Accessible parking areas are clearly indicated on the parking map and are in areas for easy access to shuttles. Please have parking hang tags visible for quicker access to designated areas.

INCOMING TRAFFIC PARKING INFORMATION:

- · Please follow signage and instructions from event staff for parking lots and traffic flow.
- All traffic flow will be incoming prior to the ceremony this process will save on time and congestion.
- If you enter on Evins Street (from North Church Street), you will be directed into parking lots on a progressive basis. Closest lots first and then next closest lots, etc.
- If you enter on Cummings Street (from Pine Street), you will be directed into parking lots on a progressive basis. Closest lots first and then next closest lots, etc.
- · Accessible parking will be located at "P9" (Beside the Jerry Richardsom Indoor Stadium) off Cumming Street.
- Faculty and staff parking will be located at the back of "P9" (Behind the Jerry Richardsom Indoor Stadium) off Cumming Street.
- Twitty Street (from Pine Street) will be closed to all incoming traffic prior to the ceremony.
- Event staff will direct all vehicles into spaces in all lots. Please be patient and follow directions.

SHUTTLES:

• Shuttle locations will be located throughout campus. These shuttles are available for those who require mobility assistance. Limited to you and one companion. Shuttles will be available before and after the ceremony at the drop-off locations.

OUTGOING TRAFFIC INFORMATION:

• Traffic will leave the same way you come in. There will be assistance to help with traffic flow immediately after the ceremony. If you come in on Evins Street, you will leave campus on Evins Street — same scenario for those entering on Cummings Street and Memorial Drive.
