This course, which consists of both lecture and lab, fulfills a general education science requirement and is required for students earning the Bachelor of Science in Environmental Studies. QUALIFICATIONS:

A masters degree, plus at least 18 additional hours of course credit and teaching experience in earth sciences or a related science discipline, are required.
