Adjunct Lecturer in the Environmental Studies Department

Wofford College invites applications for an adjunct lecturer in the Environmental Studies Department for the fall 2021 semester (September through mid-December). The adjunct lecturer will instruct: (1) one section with lab of a course titled "Introduction to Earth System Science" at the 100 level and (2) an upper-level focus course with lab in the applicant's field of expertise. If conditions permit, field-based lab activities are encouraged at our Goodall Center for Environmental Studies, about 20 minutes from campus.

Wofford's Environmental Studies Department provides an interdisciplinary foundation for students to address the complex environmental problems of their generation by recognizing that approaches from the humanities and arts, natural sciences and social sciences are all needed for effective local, regional and global change. Qualified applicants will have a Ph.D. (ABD welcome) or masters + 18 hours minimum in an environmental science field.

Application materials include: (1) a cover letter; (2) curriculum vitae; (3) statement of teaching philosophy incorporating information about the proposed upper-level course; and (4) three references with accompanying contact information.
